

Technology Production Project #6

Description of Completed Project

Students will present information about a social issue or conflict that affects teenagers' lives today in a 3 1/2 to 5 minute videotape format. The project is worth 125 points.

Format

Every Project should include:

1. A reporter stand-up
2. Graphics showing relevant statistical information
3. Video footage with voice-over.
4. On camera statements or interviews
5. Ending graphics (Ending credits include personnel and job descriptions of group members, special guests/interviews, and acknowledgments.)

Method

1. Describe the social issue or conflict.
2. Define the problems associated with this issue.
3. Present research information and statistical data.
4. Present various views/ options on the topic:
 - a. quotes/comments
 - b. interviews
 - c. statements on-camera
5. Identify possible solutions or outcomes to the topic.

Notes

1. Begin researching your project immediately
2. Contact several professionals related to your topic for information and possible on-camera interviews.
3. Additional information and video footage may be available from the local library or school media center.
